**NOTICE OF THE REPRESENTATION PERIOD FOR THE  
WEST OF BEWBUSH  
ALTERNATIVE DEVELOPMENT SITES  
AND BOUNDARY CHANGES**

The West of Bewbush Joint Area Action Plan (JAAP) will form part of the Local Development Frameworks for both Horsham District Council and Crawley Borough Council. It allocates a new neighbourhood of 2,500 homes and associated uses to the west of Bewbush, Crawley.

The West of Bewbush Submission JAAP was jointly submitted by Horsham District Council and Crawley Borough Council to the Secretary of State for consideration on 30 May 2008. This was followed by a statutory six week period for receipt of representations, which concluded on 11 July 2008. A number of the representations received during the representation period sought additional, alternative or amended site allocations or boundaries for the proposals included in the West of Bewbush Submission JAAP.

As the next stage in the JAAP process, the Councils are publishing the 'Alternative Development Sites and Boundary Changes' document on 22 August 2008 for representations. The sites and boundary changes identified in this document are those put forward by respondents to the submission JAAP; **they are not changes being put forward by the Councils**. They are proposals that are not included in the West of Bewbush Submission JAAP; however, the respondent(s) consider they should be included in the JAAP. The Councils themselves will not decide whether the alternative development sites and boundary changes should be included in the JAAP; it will be for the independent planning Inspector to make those decisions at an Examination in Public to be held early next year.

If you have any views on the alternative sites or boundary changes that have been proposed, representations need to be made during the six week statutory consultation period. There are two ways in which representations can be submitted:
