**NOTICE OF SUBMISSION OF THE  
WEST OF BEWBUSH  
JOINT AREA ACTION PLAN AND PROPOSALS MAPS**

The West of Bewbush Joint Area Action Plan will form part of the Local Development Frameworks for both Horsham District Council and Crawley Borough Council. The West of Bewbush Joint Area Action Plan allocates a new neighbourhood of 2,500 homes and associated uses to the west of Bewbush, Crawley. The Submission Joint Area Action Plan centres on a conceptual masterplan, and provides policies which must be adhered to ensure the development of a neighbourhood. The Proposals Maps for the District and the Borough identify the location of the West of Bewbush neighbourhood. Background documents, including the Sustainability Appraisal/Strategic Environmental Assessment, provide further technical information regarding the Submission Joint Area Action Plan.

Notice is hereby given that the West of Bewbush Joint Area Action Plan, Sustainability Appraisal/Strategic Environmental Assessment, Proposals Maps (for both Councils) and supporting documentation will be submitted to the Secretary of State on **30 May 2008**. This will be followed by a six week period for receipt of representations during which interested parties are invited to make formal representations. Representations will be considered by a Secretary of State appointed Inspector, who will assess the 'soundness' of the Joint Area Action Plan at an Examination.
